

J-Bolts, Galvanized for "G" and "XL" Carriages





USE: Threaded anchor bolt for self-supporting carriages.

FIXING: For cementing in the concrete base

RECYCLING: Disposal as ferrous material in accordance with the current laws in the country of installation.



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


J-Bolt Tie Rod

Once the foundation is laid, fill the hole with cement until the excavation area is covered.


Sink or hang the tie rods in the concrete so they will be equally centered on the slab and tail end of the gate.

Be sure the center-to-center distance on the carriages is as specified on your configuration sheet (letter "I").






Line up the bolts.
Use a string line,
template, or other
means to ensure
bolts are correctly
spaced apart. Use the
(I) dimension from
the project summary.
Line up with the
other carriage and
run parallel to the
gate opening.



Note: The pad can start under the fence line. This is done to keep the gate face at no more than 2-1/4" from the fence line and to avoid entrapment.



Note: The top of the bolt/tie rod should stick out of the cement at least 2". Keep nut on top of concrete, do not sink in.
